

AROUND THE WORLD

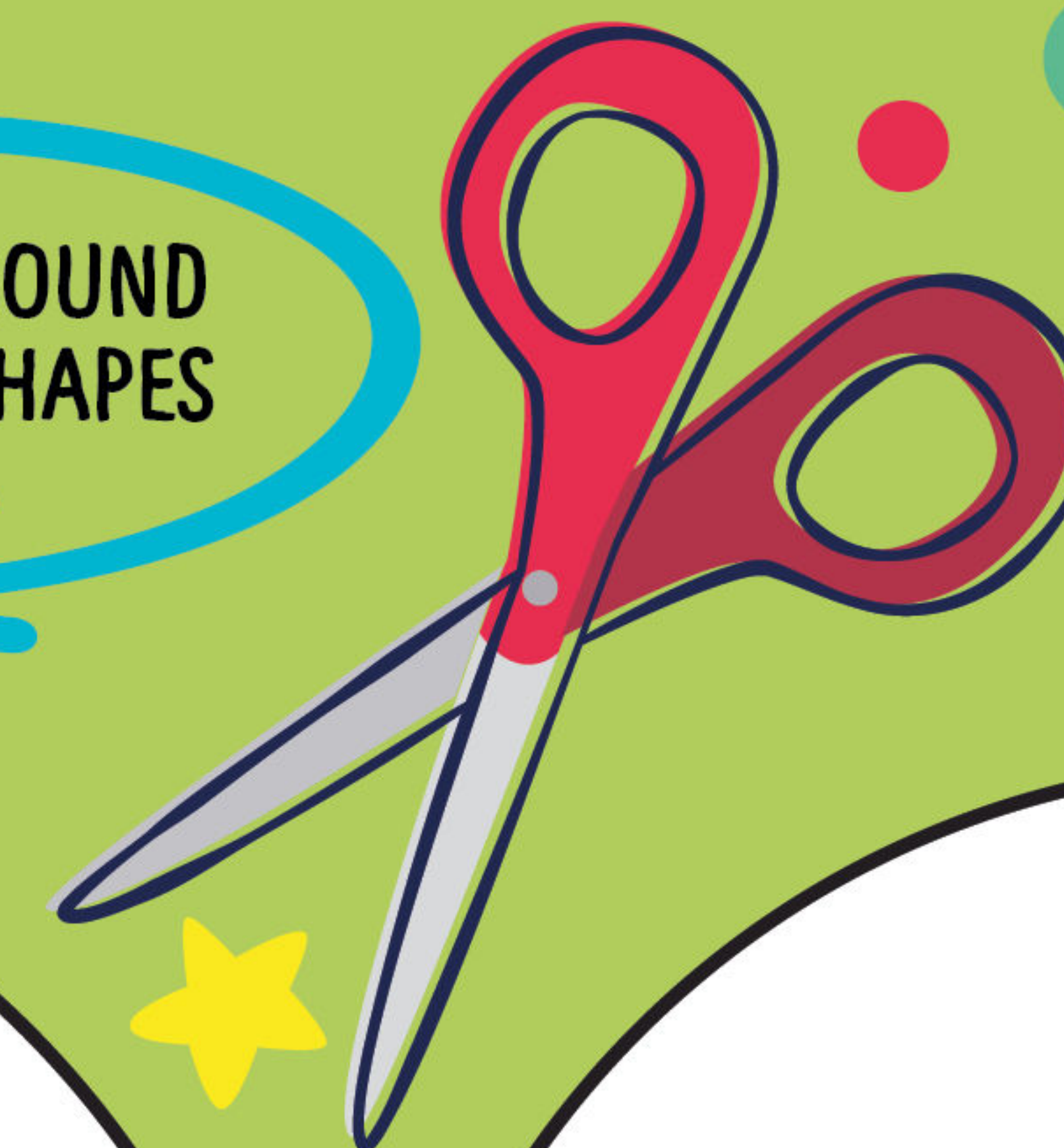
Make your own 3D paper globe for your school desk or bedroom bookshelf. See how big the world is after all!

INSTRUCTIONS

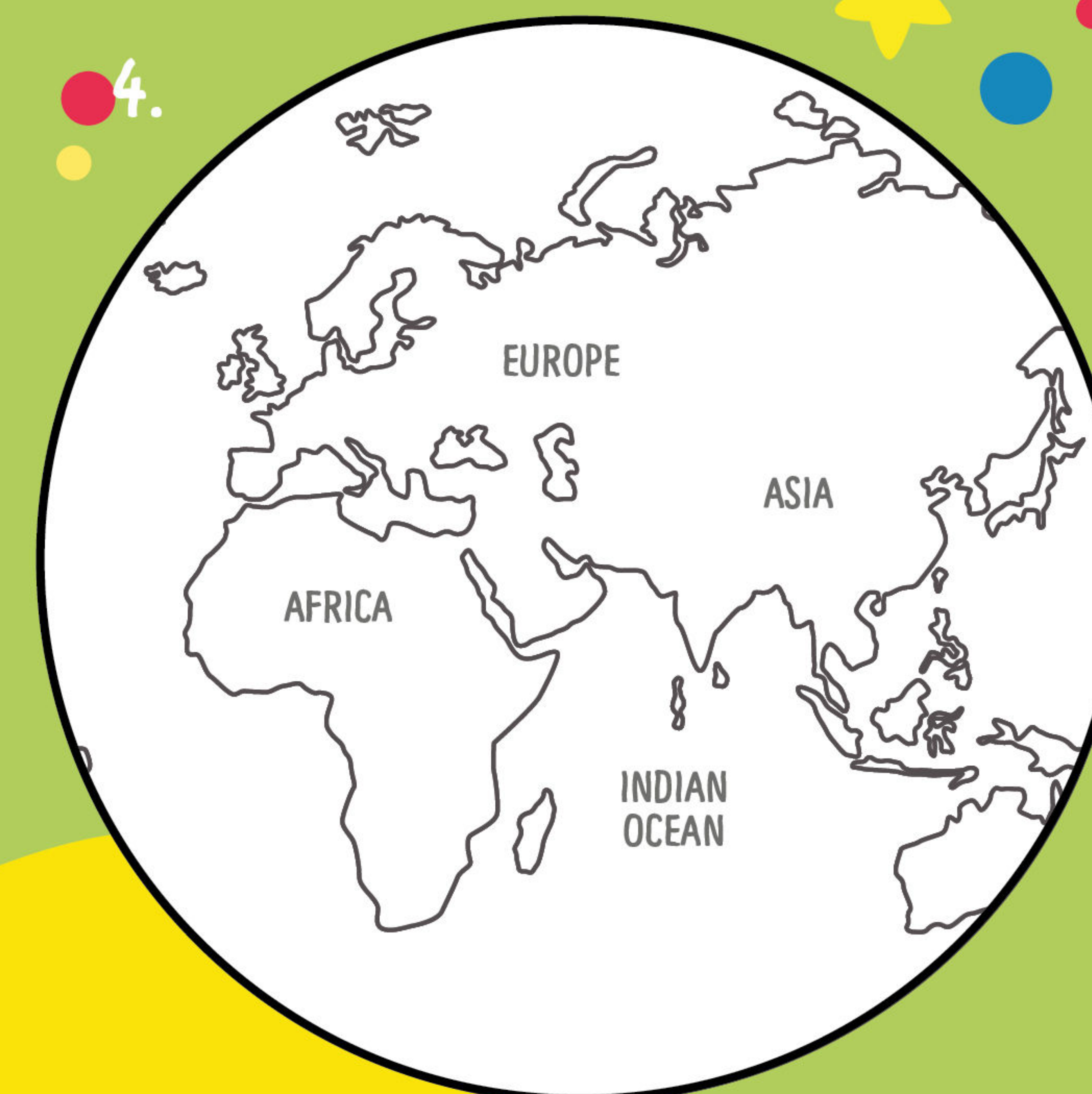
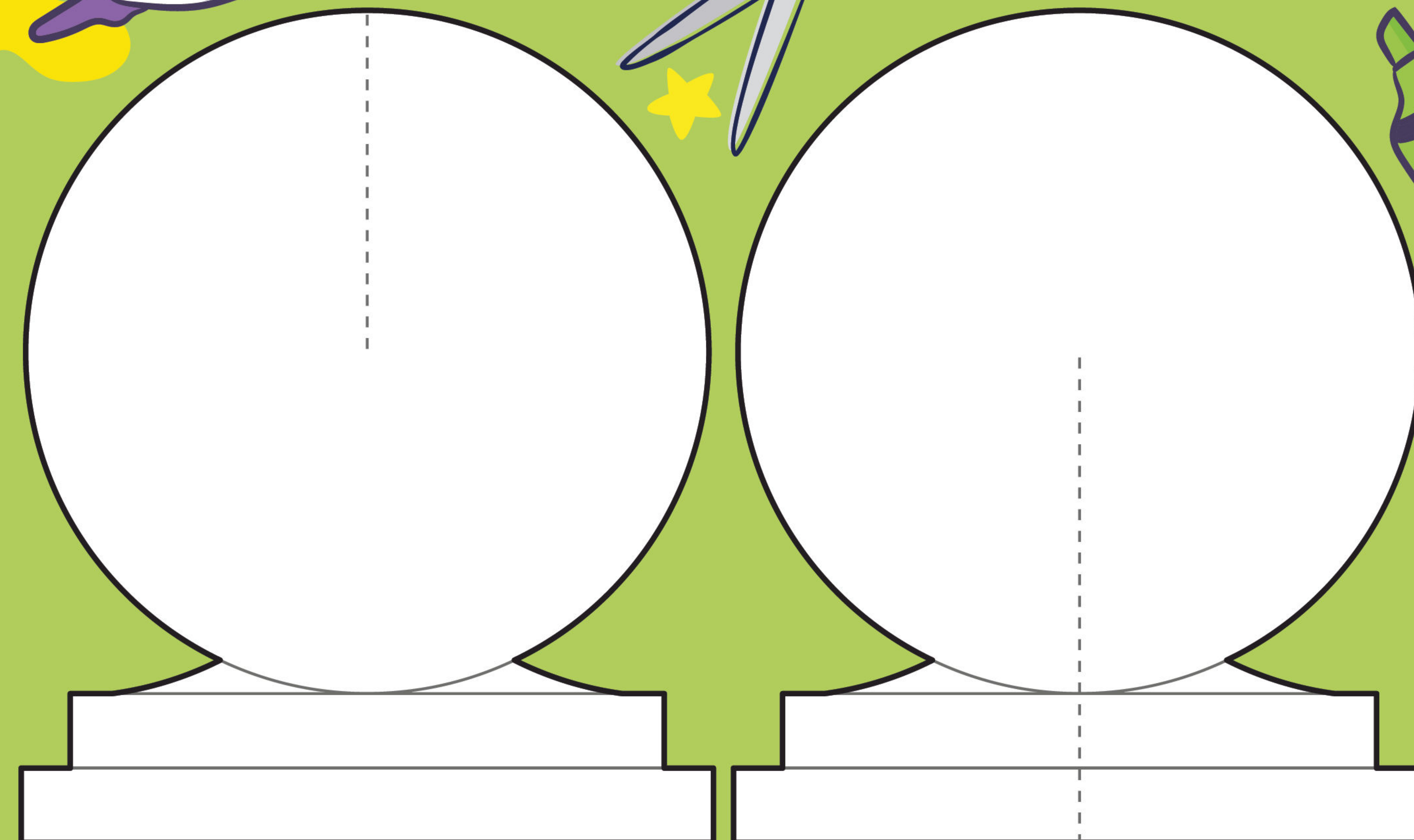
1. Cut out the globes on this page and the next one. Label each one with its number.
2. Colour in the continents and the oceans. Fold each one in half: the continents and oceans should be on the side. Open them up again.
3. Take the blank globes and cut along the dotted lines. One should have a cut from the bottom and the other one should have a cut from the top.
4. Slide the one with the cut from the bottom into the one with the cut from top. The globe should be able to stand on its own.
5. Put glue on the back of the coloured-in globe labelled with "1". Paste it onto the standing globe.
6. Turn the globe to the left and do the same thing with the coloured-in globe labelled "2". Then, do the same thing with the "3" and "4" globe, too.



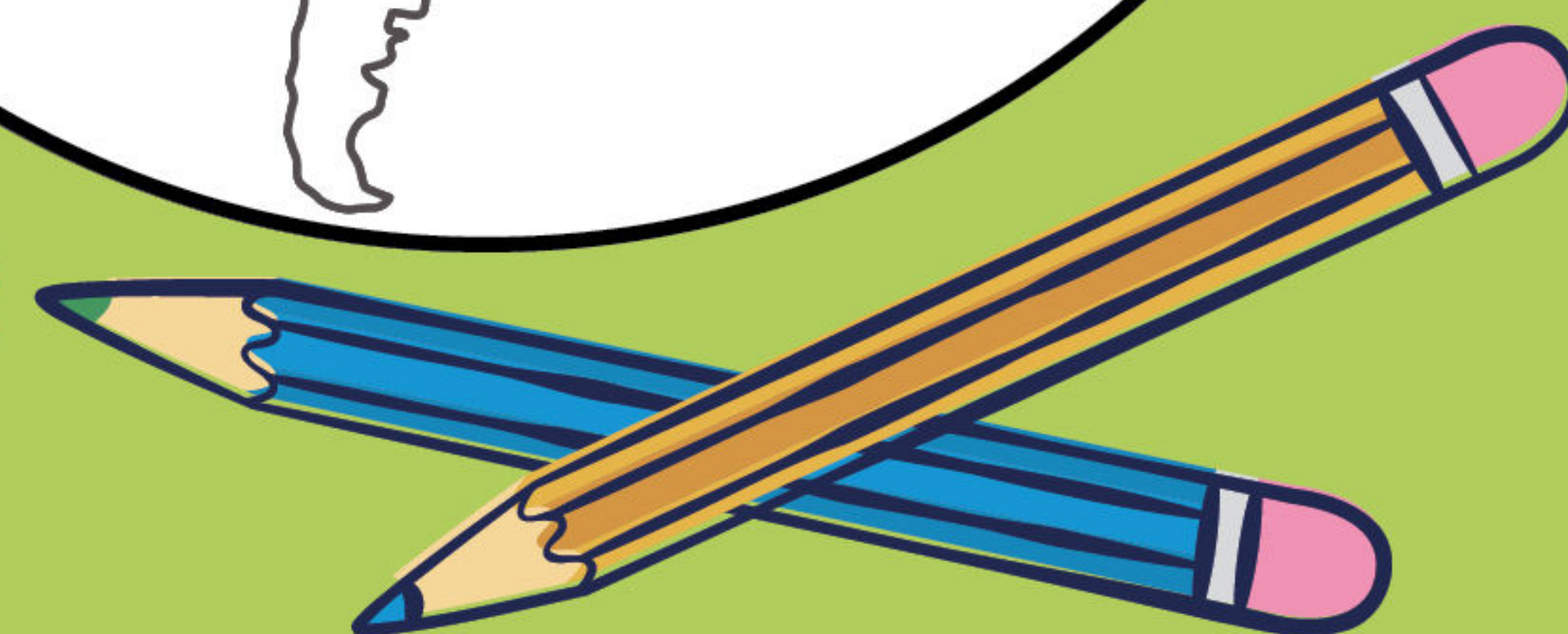
