## AROUND THE WORLD

Make your own 3D paper globe for your school desk or bedroom bookshelf. See how big the world is after all!

## INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Cut out the globes on this page and the next one. Label each one with its number.
- 2. Colour in the continents and the oceans.

  Fold each one in half: the continents and oceans should be on the side. Open them up again.
- 3. Take the blank globes and cut along the dotted lines. One should have a cut from the bottom and the other one should have a cut from the top.
- 4. Slide the one with the cut from the bottom into the one with the cut from top. The globe should be able to stand on its own.
- **5.** Put glue on the back of the coloured-in globe labelled with "1". Paste it onto the standing globe.
- 6. Turn the globe to the left and do the same thing with the coloured-in globe labelled "2". Then, do the same thing with the "3" and "4" globe, too.
